2025 Food Truck Permits Information



As we get closer to spring and plans begin for outdoor events that bring in food trucks, we wanted to share a reminder regarding food vendor/mobile restaurant permits. If you are planning to host a food vendor or mobile restaurant within city limits, please be aware that an annual permit for the vendor is required, whether on public or private property. While this permit has been a requirement for years, enforcement has recently become more consistent to ensure fairness for all businesses. Our local restaurants support the community through local taxes, so requiring a permit for mobile food vendors ensures everyone contributes to the local economy. The permit is \$50 and allows vendors to serve within New Hampton for the entire year. If you are organizing an event that includes food vendors, please remind them to obtain a permit which can be found [HERE](#). Each December, the city will send annual renewal reminders to help vendors stay up to date. Thank you for helping us maintain a fair and thriving business environment!
